<u>ELIGIBILITY</u> – This series is open to all boats that meet the CRCA Class Rules and compete in a CRCA Class. Highlights of these rules include:

- Downwind Sail Area/Displacement ratio of less than 60
- To be Eligible for the North Sails Trophy you must by July 28
 - Have a current ORRez certificate with measured sails
 - o Be a "Full Member" of a CRCA Fleet

CLASSES

• While the events included in this series are score by CRCA class, <u>the BOTY Series is</u> scored on a consolidated "single class" basis and includes only those boats sailing the same course as the CRCA Cruiser class. In addition to the Overall Perpetual Award there may be trophies to both CRCA Racer Division & CRCA Cruiser Division.

SERIES SCORING

- Scoring is Low Point. Best 5 races. If less than 7 races are completed it will be best 4 races.
 - Boats that are not entered for a race will be scored 1 more that the boats that participate in the Series.
 - Boats entered but did not come to the starting area will be scored 1 more than the number of starters.
 - Boats that come to the starting area but do not finish will be scored 1 more than the last finisher except that a boat scored DNE will be scored 1 more than starters and not allowed to discard that race.
