This regatta is open to all boats in the following:

Handicap Division: CHESSS, CRCA*, Multihull & PHRF. Classes in each division will be based on participation. Participants competing in a handicap class shall have a valid 2021 handicap certificate.

One design: Any CBYRA Sanctioned One-Design with at least 3 boats entered.

* - This event is included in the North of the Bridge Sailing Association (NBSA) Spring Series.

Rendezvous: At 1545 at Region 2 Chesapeake Bay Area Mark "T" Baltimore Light. There will be a mandatory check in.

Signals: First signal at 1600 hrs. See event Sailing Instruction for further details.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Rules: The race shall be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021–2024. The Event Sailing Instructions will be emailed to each participant no later than Thursday, 9 June 2021 and posted on the Official Notice Board, located electronically at www.psasailing.org.

Safety: All entries shall adhere to **US Sailing Equipment Requirements (SER)**, Revision 2021.0 for Nearshore. A copy of Nearshore requirements is available at <http://eastportyc.org/racing>, located under "Racing Resources." A yacht abandoning the race shall report to the Race Committee via phone: 410-255-6280 or VHF Channel 72.

Start: Between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and Region 2 Chesapeake Bay Area Mark "T" Baltimore Light.

Course: One (1) fixed mark course as defined in sailing instructions using marks listed in the 2021 GSI as Region 2, Chesapeake Bay Area Standard Racing Marks. Duration of the race is expected to be roughly 5 hours.

Time limit: None: A yacht finishing after the Race Committee has left station must take her own time and report to the Race Committee via VHF 72 or phone: 240-409-1234.

Finish: Same as start unless the course is shortened. Yachts are requested to identify themselves when finishing by shining a light upon their sail numbers.

Scoring: PHRF handicap scoring will be in accordance with the Time-On-Time Circular Random rating.

Protests: Postmarked by Tuesday 15 June 2021 and sent to the above address for entry; call first. Hearings to begin at 1800 on Friday 25 June 2021 at PSA Clubhouse, 283 Cove Road off Lake Shore Drive and Ferry Point Road, Pasadena, MD.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5 & 3rd/7 finishers. Presented at the PSA Fall Party in November 2021. Invitations will be sent to all award winners.

Social: Conduct of any post-race social activities will depend on the situation surrounding COVID at the time of the race. An announcement concerning the post-race plans will be made in the weeks before the race.

If conditions warrant, Skippers and Crew are invited to a hearty and fun 'Sailor's Breakfast' at the PSA Club House immediately after finish. PSA is located on Black Hole Creek, north side of the Magothy River, 30 minutes from finish. Head westerly up the Magothy River to Mark R10, then north into Blackhole creek. Leave the island to port. Complimentary dockage available for overnights.

Other: Each boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

This is a Clean Race; all competitors are strongly encouraged to use multi-use rather than disposable bottles, and to recycle whenever possible. A competitor shall not intentionally put trash in the water.
