Handicap Division: CHESSS, CRCA, ORC, Multihull & PHRF. Classes in each division will be based on participation. Participants competing in a handicap class shall have a valid handicap certificate. Corinthian/Novice" class for less experienced/intense owners. Free

Assigned ratings.

One design: Any CBYRA Sanctioned One-Design with at least 3 boats entered.

Rendezvous: At 1545 at Region 2 Chesapeake Bay Area Mark "T" Baltimore Light. There will be a mandatory

check in.

Signals: First signal at 1600 hrs. See event Sailing Instruction for further details.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Rules: The race shall be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021–

2024. The Event Sailing Instructions will be emailed to each participant no later than Thursday, 5 June 2023 and posted on the Official Notice Board, located electronically at

Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and Region 2 Chesapeake Bay Area Mark "T"

Baltimore Light.

Course: One (1) fixed mark course as defined in sailing instructions using marks listed in the

2025 CBYRA Green Book GSI as Region 1, Chesapeake Bay Area Standard Racing

Marks.

Time limit: None: A yacht finishing after the Race Committee has left station must take her own

time and report to the Race Committee via VHF 72 or phone: 410-375-5994.

Finish: Same as start unless the course is shortened. Yachts are requested to identify themselves

when finishing by shining a light upon their sail numbers. In addition, all finishers are required to text or email (contact info above) the following information: name of yacht, sail

#, time of finish and boats directly ahead and astern (if identifiable).

Scoring: PHRF handicap scoring will be in accordance with the Time-On-Time Circular Random rating.

Protests: Postmarked by Tuesday 10 June 2025 and sent to the above email address for entry; call first.

Hearings to begin at 1800 on Friday 27June 2025 at PSA Clubhouse, 283 Cove Road off Lake

Shore Drive and Ferry Point Road, Pasadena, MD.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5 & 3rd/7 registrants. Presented at the PSA Fall Party in November 2023.

Invitations will be sent to all award winners.

Social:

If conditions warrant, all Skippers and Crew are invited to a hearty and fun 'Sailor's Breakfast' at the PSA Club House immediately after finish. PSA is located on Black Hole Creek, north side of the Magothy River, 30 minutes from finish. Head westerly up the Magothy River to Mark R10, then north into Blackhole creek. Leave the island to port. Complimentary dockage available for overnighters, contact us to make

arrangements by Friday, June 6.

Other:

Each boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

This is a Clean Race; all competitors are strongly encouraged to use multi-use rather than disposable bottles, and to recycle whenever possible. A competitor shall not intentionally put trash in the water.
