ELIGIBILITY

All PHRF boats and sailors are welcome to this event.

Spinnaker, Non-Spin, & X-Class

REGISTRATION

Pre-Registration may be virtual prior to the skipper's meeting by sending an email to small-boat-captain@bbsc.com (or post on GroupMe). If you have raced in a BBSC event before, just state your intentions to race, and what class you will compete in. If you're new to us (or your boat is), please also include the boat make/model/year, sail number, and base rating. Please send your crew listing to Dinger Redinger (as best as you know it) before the race starts so he can include them for a prize drawing after the race. Otherwise, registration will start an hour prior to the skipper's meeting.
