1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. The sailing instructions (SIs) will be available electronically online at the official noticeboard.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The online official notice board is located at: https://nextsailor.com/regatta/2022CBCC
- 3.2. On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The VHF channel will be defined in the SIs.

4. ELIGIBIITY & ENTRY

- 4.1. The race is open to all PHRF rated boats.
- 4.2. Eligible boats may register electronically at nextSailor.com, at the following Link: https://nextsailor.com/regatta/2022CBCC

5. FEES

- 5.1. The entry fee is \$20 per boat.
- 5.2. Anybody that has already signed up and paid to compete in "Challenge Cup" that no longer wants to compete will be refunded at the earliest opportunity. Please contact the Fleet Captain.

6. CLASSES

- 6.1. All boats will compete as a single fleet.
- 6.2. At least three boats from each club must compete to constitute a team.

8. COURSES

8.1. The racing area will be located on the waters of the Choctawhatchee Bay

8.2. The courses will be Windward/Leeward with dropped marks, or Random Leg course(s), or a combination of both.

8.3. The exact courses will be defined in the SIs.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1. Any changes to RRS 44.1 will be outlined in the SIs.

10.SCORING

- 10.1. The Low Point System of Appendix A of the RRS will apply.
- 10.2. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 10.3. Scoring will be by club team with team size determined by the club with the fewer number of boats.
- 10.4. RRS A2 is changed so that a team series score shall be the total of her individual boat scores.

11. PRIZES

11.1. The winning club team will be awarded the Bay Challenge Trophy

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1. RRS 3 States the following: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform, and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury, or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.

13.BERTHING

- 13.1. The Bluewater Bay Marina T-Dock has been cleared of all transient traffic to make room for CBCC racing boats to occupy from Friday afternoon to Saturday evening.
- 13.2. Up to seven (7) foot drafts can navigate into Bluewater Bay Marina depending on the rise/fall of the bayou.



- 13.3. Regardless of draft, if any skipper does not want to enter the marina, that is fine. Crews & boats will be standing by to (at a minimum) bring crews from boats anchored outside the marina to the awards event.
- 13.4. Please contact the Fleet Captain for reservations, local knowledge, and arrangements to dock, anchor, or provide a launch for transport.
