RULES

The race will be governed by the current 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY

All PHRF boats and sailors are welcome to this event, however every boat must have a female helmswoman for the entire race. Specific details about leaving the slip, bio-breaks, and docking the boat will be covered in the Sis...and I'm sure they will be controversial...but they will be covered later. You have about a week to bother me about it. **YOU MUST HAVE A FEMALE HELMSWOMAN.**

CLASSES

Spinnaker, & X-Class (that is not a typo. Those are the classes for the Lady Bug Race).

REGISTRATION

Registration will be in-person prior to the skipper's meeting. You may pre-register by sending an email to small-boat-captain@bbsc.com (or post on GroupMe). If you have raced in a BBSC event before, just state your intentions to race, and what class you will compete in. If you're new to us (or your boat is), please also include the boat make/model/year, sail number, and base rating. Please send your crew listing to Dinger Redinger (as best as you know it) before the race starts so he can include them for a prize drawing after the race.

RACING VENUE

The racing area will be the waters of Rocky Bayou, and Choctawhatchee Bay.

COURSE

To be described in the sailing instructions, and/or as modified at the skipper’s meeting. Expect a combination of government and club marks, with an approximate length of 6-11 NM.

AWARDS

Awards will be presented at the Schooner’s pavilion after the race. The awards presentation will begin approximately one hour after the race committee returns to the BWB marina.
