1. **RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events and the Thistle Class Southeastern Series Regatta Guidelines for 2015.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY 2.

- The regatta is open to GYA Capdevielle, Flying Scot, Thistle, One-design classes, Open Portsmouth, and Open Multihull. 2.1
- A minimum of five (5) boats is required to constitute an Open or One-design fleet. 2.2
- 2.3 Eligible Non-Capdevielle boats may enter by remitting the registration form together with the required fee.
