1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of RRS 60.3, 63.2, and 63.4 will not apply.

2. ADVERTISING

The Catalina 22 National Sailing Association does not permit additional advertising as outlined in ISAF Regulation 20.3.1.2 (ISAF Regulation 20.5.7).

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Participation in the capacity of skipper/helmsman shall be limited to owners of Catalina 22 sloops (and their immediate families) who are members of the Catalina 22 National Sailing Association in good standing.
- 3.2 Eligible competitors may enter by completing the entry form and remitting the required fees. Online registration is available at the FWYC website. Checks should be made payable to **Fort Walton Yacht Club** and mailed to:

4. CLASSES

There will be two class fleets and one spinnaker fleet:

	1
Genoa Gold Fleet	Open to all skippers eligible to sail the Regatta. The winner will be the 2016 National Champion.
Genoa Silver Fleet	Limited to skippers who have not received a first place trophy in any Catalina 22 state, regional or
	national regatta.
Spinnaker Fleet	Must also be registered in either Gold or Silver Fleet.

5. FEES

- 5.1 The early registration fee is \$250.00 if registered prior to May 1, 2016. After May 1, 2016 the fee is \$275.00.
- 5.2 Entries may be accepted after 0900 on May 23, 2016 by permission of the FWYC Fleet Captain.
- 5.3 The entry fee includes the skipper and one crewmember. A Hospitality Fee of \$65.00 is required for each additional crewmember and/or guest. Fees include regatta memorabilia and admittance to all parties and functions.
- 5.4 The Registration Form will be published in the January 2016 issue of *MainBrace* magazine and available online at (*http://www.nextsailor.com/app/page/regatta/67*), on the FWYC website (www.fwyc.org), and the Catalina 22 National Association Website (www.catalina22.org). Early registration will close on May 1, 2016. Receipt of registration will be determined by the postmark on the envelope or when received by the Registrar if hand delivered.

7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1 Each boat shall comply and produce a valid Measurement Certificate before the close of registration at 0900, May 23, 2016.
- 7.2 All sails must be measured according to C22 One Design Rules.
- 7.3 Section H (Required Safety Equipment) of the C22 One Design Rules will be enforced. <u>A boat may be inspected at any time</u> <u>during the regatta</u>

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be accessible after May 15, 2016 on the FWYC website (www.fwyc.org), the Catalina 22 website (www.catalina22.org) and provided in the Skipper's Packet at the Registration Desk at the FWYC.

9. VENUE

The racing area will be located east of FWYC on the waters of the Choctawhatchee Bay.

10. COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward with an offset mark and gate.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 11.2 Seven races will be scheduled for the Gold and Silver Fleet with three races constituting a Regatta. Four races will be scheduled for the Spinnaker Fleet with one race constituting a Regatta.
- 11.3 No race scores will be excluded. This changes Rule A2.

12. BERTHING AND HAUL-OUT

- 12.1 All boats must be launched by 1030 on Monday May 23, 2016 and remain in the water unless written permission is granted by the race PRO.
- 12.2 The club hoist will not accommodate Catalina 22s therefore boats must be trailer launched.
- 12.3 Dry berthing will not be available.

13. PRIZES

- 13.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three (3) boats in each fleet with five boats or more.
- 13.2 The Betty Gay Clements perpetual trophy will be awarded in accordance with its deed.
- 13.3 The Dick King Memorial trophy for the highest place Sport will be awarded in accordance with its deed.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Fort Walton Yacht Club will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
