1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, *GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events* and the *GYA Sportboat Championship and Interclub Series 2016-2017*.
- 1.2 The *Viper 640 Class Association Rules for Coaching and Crew* is modified as follows:
 10.5 Coaching shall be permitted between races.
 10.6 To allow Capdevielle competitors the opportunity to also race the Viper 640, helmsman and crew changes shall be permitted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to one-design boats of the following classes: GYA Capdevielle Flying Scot, Viper 640, Thistle, A-Class catamaran, Hobie 16; and other One Design Classes
- 2.2 Classes with five (5) or more registered boats shall constitute a fleet. There will not be a mixed Portsmouth rated Open fleet.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by remitting the registration form together with the required fee.

3. FEES

- 3.1 Entry Fee: Capdevielle, None; Thistles, \$53 per boat; and Other entries, \$50 per boat.
- 3.2 The Non-Capdevielle Entry Fee includes one (1) ticket for a Shrimp Boil.
- 3.3 Additional tickets are available at \$15.00 per person.
