#### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

#### 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on the Club bulletin board and will be available at registration.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all ORR-EZ rated boats, provided each boat is sailed "Double Handed".
- 3.2 Fleet classification: A (IR# less than 680), B (IR# 680 and above) and Multihull (PHRF)
- 3.3 A minimum of two (2) boats will constitute a fleet.
- 3.4 2.6 Eligible boats may enter by registering at <u>https://nextsailor.com/app/page/reg\_boat/678</u> and remitting the required fee.

#### 4. FEES

The entry fee is \$15.00 per boat.
