1. RULES & SCORING

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

2. COMMUNICATION

- 2.1. This Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and notices to competitors will be available upon release electronically online at the official noticeboard at: <https://nextsailor.com/regatta/2023BBSCRTTP> (QR Code above), also posted in hardcopy on the BBSC corkboard in LJ Schooner's Oyster Bar (in the big-screen TV area).

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1. This series is open to all PHRF rated boats. The Fleet Captain will assign you a rating if you do not have one.
- 3.2. Register electronically at the link in 2.1 (above), or in-person prior to the competitor's meeting.
- 3.3. Fees: The PHRF entry fee is \$30 per boat per race, or one-time \$200 for the season.

4. CLASSES

- 4.1. One Class, X-Class: X-Class is a back-calculated rating based on prior performance in BBSC events. Contact the Fleet Captain (info below) with questions.
