

NOTICE OF RACE

2023 BBSC Double-Handed Race

Saturday, September 9th

1. RULES & SCORING

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. Special Instruction: This "Double Handed" race will require each vessel to have only two persons aboard.

2. COMMUNICATION

2.1. This Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and notices to competitors will be available upon release electronically online at the official noticeboard at: https://nextsailor.com/regatta/BBSCdoublehanded2023 (QR Code above) and also posted in hardcopy on the BBSC corkboard in LJ Schooner's Oyster Bar (in the big-screen TV area).

3. ELIGIBIITY & ENTRY

- 3.1. This series is open to all PHRF rated boats. The Fleet Captain will assign you a rating if you do not have one.
- 3.2. Register electronically at the link in 2.1 (above), or in-person prior to the competitor's meeting.
- 3.3. Fees: The PHRF entry fee is \$30 per boat per race, or one-time \$200 for the season.

4. CLASSES

- 4.1. Spinnaker Class, using legacy GYA PHRF TOD ratings.
- 4.2. X-Class: X-Class is a back-calculated rating based on prior performance in BBSC events. Contact the Fleet Captain (info below) with questions.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. Saturday, September 9th
 - 9:30 In-Person Registration @ L.J. Schooner's Pavilion
 - 10:30 Competitor's meeting
 - 12:30 First Warning (all classes)
 - 17:00 Results & Awards @ L.J. Schooner's after boats return

6. COURSES

- 6.1. The racing areas will be located on the waters of the Choctawhatchee Bay and Rocky Bayou.
- 6.2. Random leg courses are planned for both classes (change from last year).

7.1. RRS 3 States the following: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that each skipper is responsible for the safety of his/her vessel and crew.
